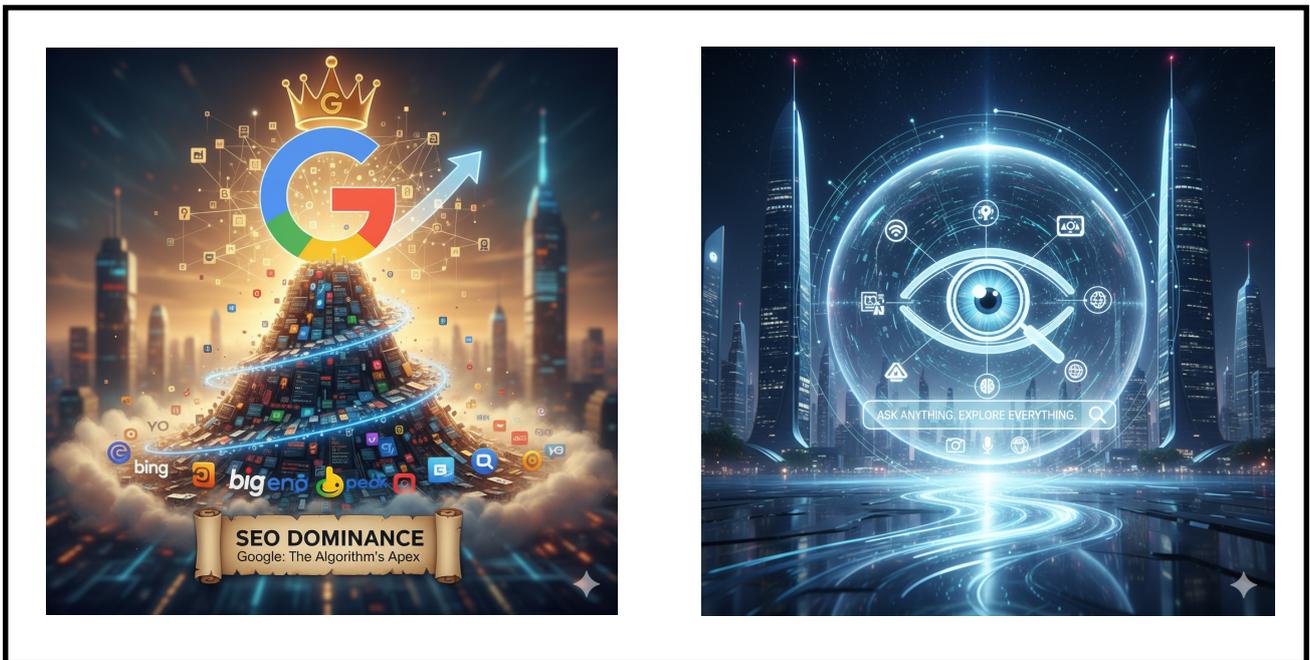

So we optimized. We built backlinks. We tweaked meta descriptions. We hunted keywords like treasure. And it worked until it didn't

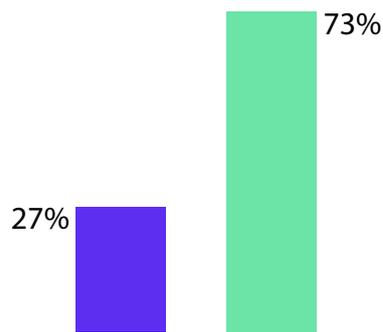
## The Reality in 2025

- In a podcast where someone casually references your competitor



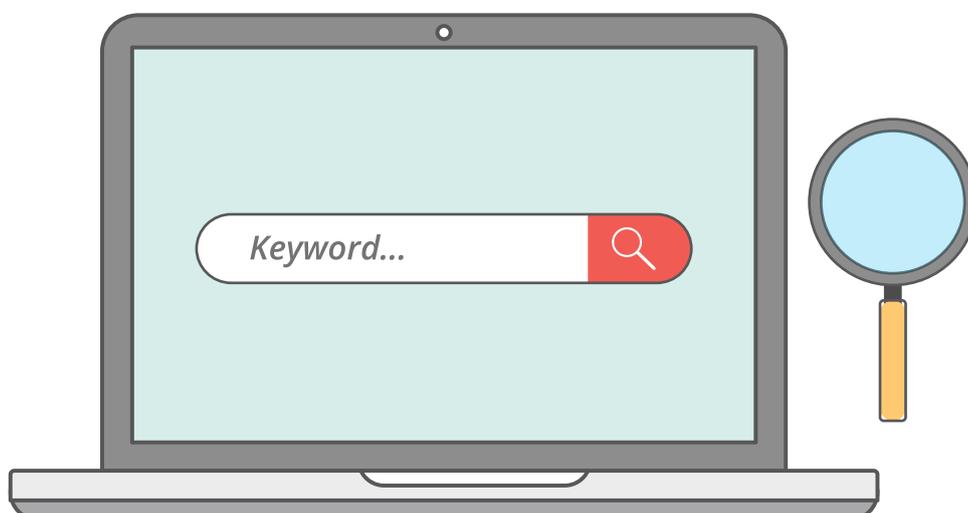

AI tools (like ChatGPT, Gemini, Claude, and Perplexity) don’t show 10 options. They show one curated answer—and often reference just 1–3 brands

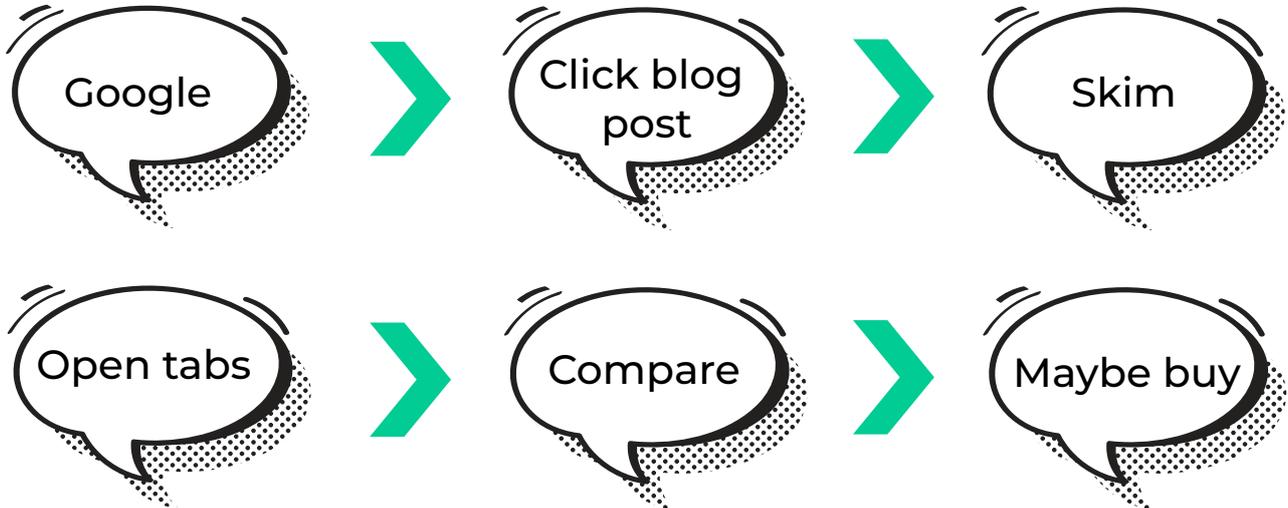
*If you’re not in that answer, you don’t exist. Period.*

That same blog post is just a starting point. If your content doesn't move across platforms, into the conversations buyers are already having, it dies silently no matter how "SEO optimized" it is.

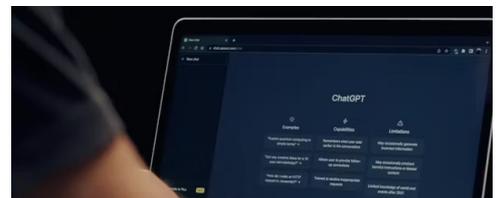
#### **Let's take a simple idea:**

- A carousel on Instagram or LinkedIn highlighting key benefits and safety tips for cleaning floors
- A ChatGPT-friendly FAQ markdown list for homeowners or businesses asking about cleaning flooring
- A blog post on your website with detailed FAQs and project tips
- A Quora or local community reply to common questions about cleaning floor installation
- A podcast segment or ad featuring customer success stories

## The Create Once, Influence Everywhere (COIE) Framework

COIE means you design content like a network, not a single asset.

### Here's how it works:

#### 1. Start With One Core Idea

A pain point, question, or experience your audience cares deeply about.

#### 2. Fragment the Format

Turn it into 7+ native versions for where people already spend attention.

#### 3. Contextualize It

Don't just repost. Adapt for tone, culture, and trust expectations on each platform.

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## 4. Decentralize It

Let others carry your message—via creators, curators, AI tools, comment sections, or even meme pages.

## 5. Track Decision Signals, Not Just Clicks

Comments, mentions, saves, shares, screenshots these now matter more than raw traffic.

## Why This Works

Each touchpoint adds social proof and platform-specific trust. People now see you in multiple places before they need you.

## So when is it time to search?

They already recognize your voice.

They've already heard your name.

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# Build the Minimum Visible Platform (MVP)

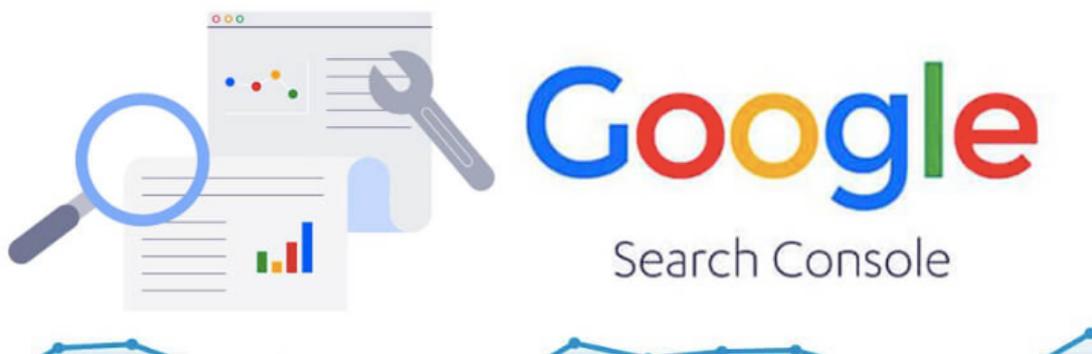

## The Simplest System for Showing Up Everywhere

You don't need to be everywhere. You just need to be findable in the places your potential Cleaning clients look first.

**The goal is to build your Minimum Visible Platform (MVP): A small set of high-impact profiles that:**

- Rank in search for Australian Cleaning services
- Communicate your expertise and value quickly
- Show proof of quality projects fast



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**For most Australian Cleaning businesses, 3–5 key platforms are enough:**

- Personal website or landing page – showcasing residential, commercial, and industrial Cleaning projects in Australia
- Google Business Profile – optimized with photos, reviews, and service areas
- LinkedIn – for connecting with builders, contractors, and commercial clients
- Facebook/Instagram – visual platforms for showing transformations, reels, and customer testimonials
- Optional: YouTube or TikTok – for tutorials, project walk-throughs, and before/after videos



**Each one should:**

- Match the keywords your target clients search for, e.g., “Cleaning flooring Sydney,” “Garage Cleaning coating Melbourne,” or “Commercial Cleaning floor Brisbane”
- Show proof in 5 seconds – before/after photos, video clips, or testimonials
- Make it clear how to hire/contact you – include phone, email, and a quick inquiry form

## CHAPTER 6

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# The Invisible Middle

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## Why Buyers Don't Convert on the First Click Anymore

### *Let's kill the myth:*

"If someone doesn't convert immediately, they're not interested"

### **Not true.**

They're just not ready yet.

### Modern buyers don't move from:



### They wander through the invisible middle—a space filled with:

- Reviews
- Forums
- YouTube comments
- Reddit threads
- TikTok duets
- Private chats
- Search engines
- AI summaries
- Even screenshots in group messages



### And guess what?

They're forming impressions in all of them.

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## What is the Invisible Middle?

It's the messy, non-linear discovery phase where buyers:

- Verify what they just heard
- Ask peers
- See how others reacted
- Search for comparisons or complaints
- Look for “signals” of credibility beyond your site

## They're not “bouncing.”

They're *investigating* but you don't see it on your dashboard.

## You Can't Track It—But You Can Influence It

You won't find these in your analytics:

- Saw your product mentioned in a TikTok comment, Googled you, then asked my friend in Slack”
- “Read your blog, then asked ChatGPT if you're legit”

## But this is how trust is built now

*Your job isn't to trap them in a funnel.*

It's to show up in the messy middle so that no matter where they look, you're present and consistent.



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## How to Build Trust Across the Middle

### 1. Be Referencable in Every Channel

Make sure your Cleaning business is searchable, mentionable, and linkable across platforms your clients use:

- **Reddit** (forums discussing home renovations, industrial flooring, or DIY projects)
- **Twitter/X** (share project updates, tips, or client wins)
- **YouTube** (showcase Cleaning transformations, tutorials, or case studies)
- **TikTok** (quick before/after clips, time-lapse projects)
- **Google** (local business listings, maps, and directories)
- **ChatGPT** (ensure your business info, reviews, and structured content are available for AI tools)
- **Review platforms** (ProductReview.com.au, Google Reviews, Houzz, etc.)



### 2. Let Others Carry Your Message

UGC (user-generated content), client reviews, contractors' referrals, and content shared by creators or curators build trust faster than self-promotion. People trust people—leverage that.

### 3. Create “Search Catchers”

Build content that addresses real client queries and decision moments, such as:

- “Is [Brand] Cleaning flooring legit in Sydney?” “[brand] vs [competitor]”
- “[Brand] vs [Competitor] Cleaning coatings” “How to use [product] if [situation]”
- “Best Cleaning flooring for garages in Melbourne”
- “How to prep concrete for Cleaning if [condition]”



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## 4. AI-Optimized Content

Be discoverable where AI curates answers:

- Make blog content summarizable for AI tools like ChatGPT
- Use schema markup for project details, reviews, and FAQs
- Answer questions as a helpful guide, not just as marketing content

## The Big Idea

People don't just search for products anymore. They search for trust.

And if they can't find it in the invisible middle?

They'll keep moving until they do.

## Your First Message = A Query Trigger

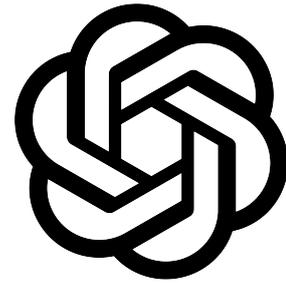
Let's say you reach out to a potential client:

After you message them, the buyer silently asks:

- “Who is this person?”

## Outbound Works When Your Search Presence Works

#### 1. Google Yourself First

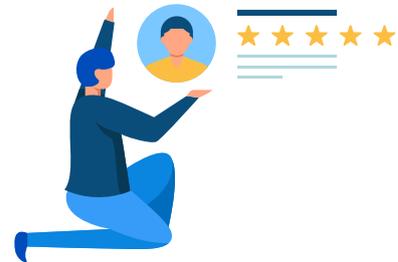
What shows up when someone types your name or brand? If it’s vague, irrelevant, or outdated—you lose by default.

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# Don't Just Post—Position

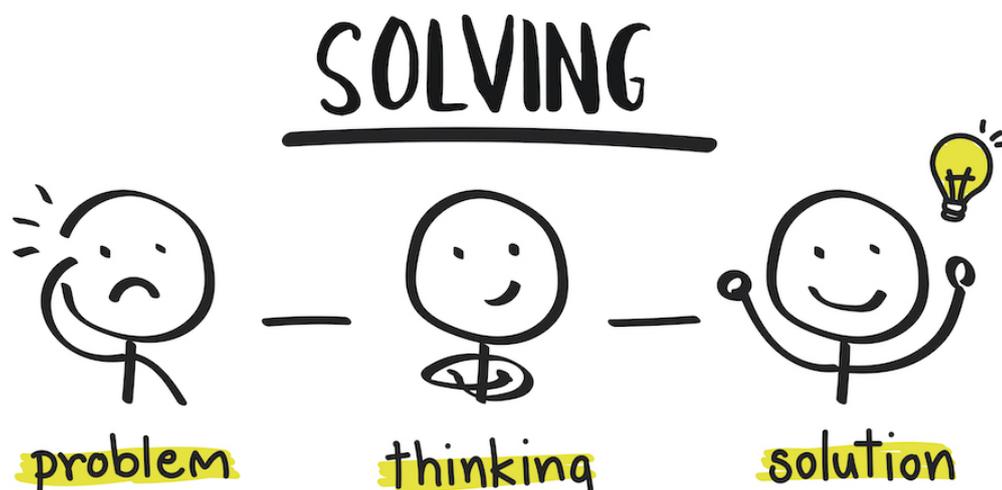

Have you taught or shared anything useful?

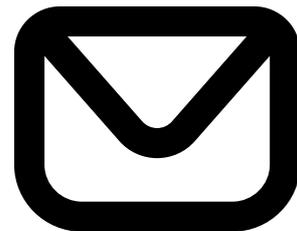
## The Best Time to Post Results Was Yesterday
